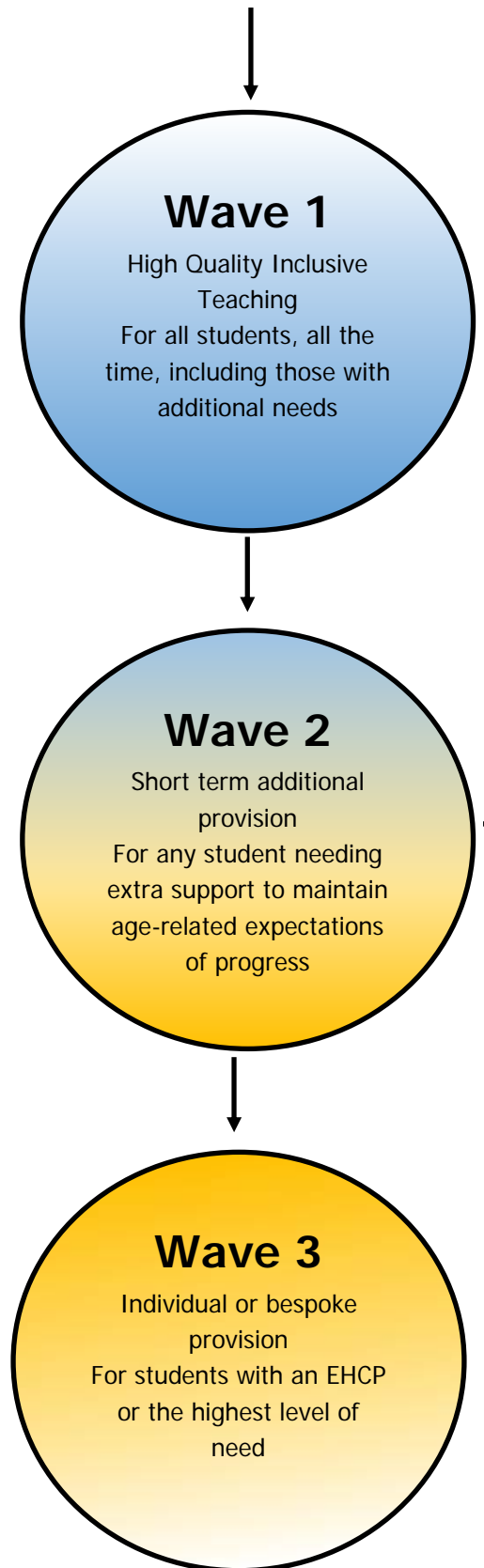


Saltash.net Provision Map 18-19



Levels of Provision



Curriculum

- High quality teaching in every lesson: qualified teachers, subject specialists
- Show My Homework
- Feedback – AFL, marking, and DIRT
- Key words/connectives lists or displays – teaching walls
- Teachers providing additional learning material, e.g. vocabulary lists, practice papers, knowledge organisers
- Personalised targets
- Differentiated resources and learning activities
- Data used to monitor progress and attainment
- Literacy and numeracy across the curriculum – policies and curriculum maps
- After school revision sessions, department intervention/catch-up
- Open options – all subjects available to all students
- CPD and training for staff in all areas of pedagogy and child development

Student Support

- Enhanced transition groups for vulnerable students KS2 to KS3
- Risk assessment for challenging behaviour

Student Support

- Alternative tutor time arrangements for some students in ARB
- Five minute early release for break times for some students in ARB

- Referral to Psychological services
