

What Independent Study Looks Like In...*English Literature*

1. Plan a response to an essay question.
2. Write your own essay question and then come up with a list of indicative content.
3. Write part/ all of an essay response.
4. Create flash cards/ Quizlet cards for key quotations for the texts we are studying- use them often.
5. Watch a video on YouTube either revising your text or exploring a different aspect of it.
6. Find a podcast that you can download and listen to (the BBC do some excellent Shakespeare ones).
7. Annotate black copies of extracts/ poems to see how much you remember.
8. Go to the library: read a chapter from a text book related to our area of study.
9. Reread the texts!
10. Go onto google books and search key phrases i.e. Othello, masculinity and make a note of critical nuggets.
