2. Research primary sources and interpretations for your coursework.
3. Consult the documentaries/you tube links on the recommended list.
Watch and make notes.
4. Plan essays based on the questions you have been given.
5. Make a timeline: overarching of key themes, focused on a specific topic.
6. Read around the subject using additional material.
7. Produce flash cards, summary charts and tables covering individual topics.
8. Play subject specific taboo.
9. Read articles from Historical Journals such as 'History Review' and on line with 'Guardian'.
10. Re-visit essays and source assessments to review and improve.
