

What Independent Study Looks Like In...*Maths & F. Maths*

1. Use the online ActiveLearn Textbook – it has worked examples and lots of questions (with answers) to practise.
2. Use the A-Level maths textbook (hardcopy) to work on topics you struggle with.
3. Get into the habit of seeking help from your teacher – we are here to help!
4. Read your teacher feedback to homework and assessments and use it to improve.
5. Redo your homework a few weeks after submitting to check you can still do it.
6. Use mathsgenie.co.uk/alevel.html and to prepare you for exams.
7. Use mathsnetalevel.com/index.php to improve exam technique
8. Complete all practise exam papers available (at least twice!).
9. Read the examiner reports which highlight common mistakes.
10. Familiarise yourself with what examiner is looking for by looking at the mark schemes.
