1. Listen to your set works as often as possible.
2. Also listen to other similar pieces, using musical terminology to describe them.
3. Write a descriptive paragraph about each of the pop/jazz/songs from musicals that you listen to in class and at home.
4. Write your own pop essay question and then come up with a list of indicative content.
5. Create flash cards/ Quizlet cards for key information for the pieces we are studying- use them often.
6. Watch a video on YouTube either revising your set works or exploring a different aspect of it.
7. Find a podcast that you can download and listen to about classical music/pop/jazz/musicals.
8. Annotate scores and use these to see how much you remember.
9. Practise your instrumental/vocal pieces every day.
10. Add some bars to your composition every day.
