CURRICULUM ENRICHMENT WEEK 2020

I am excited to be able to share with you the wonderful range of activities available for our young people during Curriculum Enrichment Week, which will run from Monday 6th to Friday 10th July 2020. On the reverse of this letter you will find the list of the options available from which you may make your selection. For more trip information we have emailed to parents the detailed choice booklet and it will also be on the school website. Additionally, trip descriptions will also be on ParentPay, if you are unable to access this information online, please call the school Reception and we can arrange for your son/daughter to bring a paper copy home with them.

We have worked hard to provide a variety of opportunities that involve learning new skills, developing curriculum areas and taking part in new experiences as well as responding to the demands of more popular options from CEW 2019. We are once again offering a range of free activities this year to ensure all pupils have the opportunity to get off site and enjoy a varied, enriching week. Please read the information with your child in order to make a decision ready for the ParentPay launch on the 31st October 2019. Responding to parental feedback we have decided to alter our ParentPay open time to 8am, our hope is that this time is more suitable for parents. To support with Wi-Fi access for anyone that requires it, the core in Saltash, has kindly offered to open their café from 8am and will provide free hot drinks and WiFi for anyone who would like to use it. Once an activity is fully booked, it will no longer show the activity as 'bookable' on ParentPay. Just so you are aware the activities have to be uploaded individually to ParentPay and although we will have several people doing this to try to ensure all trips are available at the same time. There will be a small time difference to be aware of. If you have any questions about ParentPay or if you have any issues on the day with the system, please do not hesitate to email cew@saltashcloud.net.

For all non-residential activities we request that a 50% deposit is paid at the time of booking to ensure your place, all non-residential activities are £100 or less. We made this move to request a deposit at the time of booking last year as many of the venues that we book and use require early deposits to secure our booking. It also means that there is less student activity change once a booking has been made and a deposit has been paid. Paying a deposit will secure the place on that activity, please only book on one activity. The free activities will also need to be booked through ParentPay, should you have any worries at all about payment or booking of activities, please email cew@saltashcloud.net or finance@saltashcloud.net. For residential activities we ask for a deposit of £50 apart from Going Dutch when we require a £100 deposit to secure a place.

We are really pleased as a school that we still offer this experience to our students as it is an important part of the school calendar, and that you as parents are so supportive with this opportunity. It is a great chance for students to develop key skills and to explore new opportunities in line with our TEAM ethos. Just to clarify that if your son/daughter is taking part in either the German exchange or Duke of Edinburgh then they will not need to book on a CEW activity as these opportunities are taking place in the same week.
