 wollen = to want
 (I) ich will
 (you) du willst
 (he/she/it) er/sie/es will
 (you plural) ihr wollt
 (we/they) wir/sie wollen

sehen = to see/watch
 (I) ich sehe
 (you) du siehst
 (he/she/it) er/sie/es sieht
 (you plural) ihr seht
 (we/they) wir/sie sehen

Saying you like to do something
 These words go after the verb:

 gern = like to

 lieber = prefer to

 am liebsten = like to most of all

Modal Verbs
 You put the modal verb at the start (conjugated) and the infinitive at the end of the clause.

 ich/man darf = I/you are allowed to
 wir/sie dürfen = we/they are allowed to
 ich/man soll = I/you should
 wir/sie sollen = we/they should
 ich/man kann = I/you can
 wir/sie können = we/they can
 ich/mann muss = I/you must
 wir/sie müssen = we/they must

Past Participles

Remember German word order is different to ours in the past tense:

I saw a film =

Ich habe einen Film gesehen.

Ich habe _____ ...

gegessen = ate

getrunken = drank

genommen = took

gebacken = baked

gekocht = cooked

gekauft = bought

Dative Case

When you use the word *mit* (with), you must add an -n onto plural nouns.

The words for *the* and *a* also change:

der = dem / einem

die = der / einer

das = dem / einem

die = den

Revision Tip

Why don't you write a recipe for your friends or family to make?

You could also write the German words for different foods and drinks on sticky notes and stick them around the kitchen!

Imperative

This is used when you want to give a command: pour the mixture into the bowl.

You form it by conjugating the verb in the *du* form and then removing the -st (sometimes you add an -e)
