1. Coastal systems

Research your favourite coastal area- a beach, a stretch of coastline, a specific landform.

Collect or take your own photograph of the feature/area

Annotate the photograph and identify the following:

- Its main physical features
- The processes that have helped to shape and change the feature- this may include erosional processes or depositional processes or subaerial processes such as weathering.

Then write a small report that summarises why this landform is of interest to you

2. Changing places

Select a place, other than the coastal place described above, and identify why it is an important place-this may be due to its location, or its characteristics, or people who live there. There is no right answer to this
